A pledge is generally subject to the same legal provisions as an early withdrawal to purchase property (Art. 30c OPA and Art. 331d CO):

- Under the age of 50, the maximum pledge amount is the current value of the insured person's retirement assets. Over the age of 50, only the assets held at the age of 50, or half of the current assets (if higher) can be pledged.
- A pledge can be made 3 years prior to retirement at the latest.
- This pledge can only be made with the written consent of the insured person's spouse or registered partner. The signature must be officially verified.

For unmarried persons, we require a current civil status certificate.

### 5. Required documents

The documents may be **no more than three months** old.

- Pledge notification from the bank
- Current pledge agreement
- Current certificate of residence (no more than 30 days old)
- Current land register extract with indication of ownership type
- If you are married or in a registered partnership: family booklet
- If you are unmarried: civil status certificate
- Payment confirmation for the transfer of CHF 200.00
